# What Has Changed in the Law?

---

Immigration rules in Portugal have undergone important changes.

Some procedures have become more demanding, and certain applications now depend on new legal criteria.

For many foreign nationals, this may mean:

- longer waiting times
- higher risk of refusal
- need for additional documentation
- difficulties with regularisation

**Understanding these changes is essential to avoid future problems.**

# Who May Be Affected?

---

Changes to the law may affect different profiles of foreign nationals who live in Portugal or intend to move to Portugal.

These may include:

- people who wish to regularise their situation
- foreign workers
- international students
- families involved in family reunification procedures
- citizens waiting for documentation
- people with pending applications

**Each situation requires specific attention and careful analysis of the documents submitted.**

# What Should You Do Now?

---

Before starting any process, it is essential to understand which rules apply to your specific case.

A simple mistake may cause:

- delays
- refused applications
- missed deadlines
- future difficulties with regularisation
